- Walk-ins welcome
- Direct access testing without the need for a doctor's order
- Out-of-pocket service
- Payment is required at the time of service
- Results will be received via your patient portal and a copy will be mailed to you
- You are responsible for sending a copy of the results to your healthcare provider

### Convenient Lab Testing:

- Easy access to help monitor and manage existing health conditions
- Establish your baseline for future comparison and provide an overview of your current health
- Monitor your health risks based on your family history
- Check up on changes in your health
- Provides early detection of disease and information helpful in planning healthy lifestyle changes

Payment via check or debit/credit card is required at the time of service. Medicare, Medicaid or private insurance will not be billed.

## Single Tests

### Blood Type Test **\$20**

Provides information on your blood group: A, B, or O. Indicates if Rhesus Antigen (Rh) is positive or negative.

### CBC with Differential **\$20**

Screens for cell abnormalities and evidence of medical conditions. Most commonly used to screen for infection, anemia and other blood disorders such as leukemia.

### Comprehensive Chemistry Panel\* **\$30**

Gives an overall picture of your health, from indicating how organ systems are functioning to levels of vital minerals and proteins. Does not include lipid panel.

### CRP, High Sensitivity **\$10**

### Estradiol **\$20**

Measures your circulating levels of estradiol, which aids in assessing ovarian function and monitoring follicular development for assisted reproduction protocols.

### Glucose Test for Blood Sugar\* **\$10**

Measures your sugar level, indicating whether your sugar metabolism is working properly.

### Hemoglobin A1C **\$10**

Measures the average sugar level over a three-month period.

### Hepatitis B Immunity Test **\$25**

Hepatitis B Surface Antibody

### INR **\$15**

Monitors the effectiveness of Coumadin therapy.

### Mononucleosis Test **\$20**

Indicates the presence of an Epstein Barr virus infection.

### Pregnancy Test, Blood **\$10**

Indicates pregnancy status, positive or negative.

### Progesterone **\$20**

Progesterone, in conjunction with estrogens, regulates reproductive tract functions during the menstrual cycle. Typically, this test is performed as a routine part of pregnancy monitoring.

### Prostate Cancer Screening **\$10**

PSA, Prostate Specific Antigen Blood Test

### Testosterone **\$20**

In males, testosterone regulates sex drive (libido), bone mass, fat distribution, muscle mass or production of red blood cells and sperm. Testosterone can be used to monitor hormone levels in patients receiving testosterone replacement therapy and transgender men who are on hormone therapy.

### Urinalysis **\$20**

Helps indicate overall wellness, from urinary tract infections to systemic illness to kidney disorders.

### Vitamin D **\$25**

Vitamin D aids in the absorption of calcium, helping to form and maintain strong bones.
